201 Ferrari Carano Fume Blanc (Sonoma).....	\$40	
Zesty flavors and aromas of tropical fruit such as kiwi, gooseberry, pineapples and mangos with a hint of grassiness, which are complemented by creamy citrus notes. Great with simple seafood dishes, this wine also pairs well with spicy and ethnic cuisines.		
202 Franciscan Chardonnay (Napa Valley).....	\$42	
Pale yellow in color. On the nose, flinty mineral notes with hints of pear compote and vanilla bean, followed by toasted hazelnuts and Meyer lemon curd. Lovely, creamy, and vibrant with honey crisp apple and pear fruit filling the palate. White nectarine and lemon zest lead to a round and generous mouthfeel with a crisp line of minerality.

- 310 Argiano Super Toscana Rosso** (Toscana).....\$50
Rich and racy young red with chocolate, currant and hints of sandalwood. Full body, chewy tannins and a long and flavorful finish. Savory and juicy. Cabernet sauvignon, syrah, merlot and a splash of sangiovese.
- 314 Chianti Classico Riserva Clemente VII** (Toscana).....\$52
Ruby-purple in the glass. Aromas of bramble and dark berry. Flavors are bright and lively; cherry cedar, raspberry, and cranberry, with oak undertones. The tannins are firm, balanced by bright acidity.
- 308 Terre Nuove Primitivo** (Puglia).....\$36

- 314 Chianti** (Italy).....\$33

- 326 Incanto Super Sicilia Doc** (Sicily).....\$48
Incanto the name says it all!!! Considered among the highest expressions of the winemaking in the region of Sicily. This terrific red wine is the result of the blending of four well known grapes. **Sangiovese, Sirha, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon**
- 322 *Amarone Classico Valpolicella** (Veneto).....\$82
Grapes: **Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara** full bodied, intense and above all elegant, the Amarone was named in the 18th century and used to identify a wine produced from late pressed drier, more concentrated grapes. This gives a much more powerful and intense taste experience.
- 311 *Salenito Brunello di Montalcino DOCG** (Toscana).....\$85
Grapes: 100% Sangiovese. The color is ruby red with garnet, the nose is broad and determined with typical varietal aromas. In the mouth it is harmonious and persistent.

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
